Pet Travel Checklist

Appropriate restraint device, travel crate, or carrier
Proof of vaccinations (consider scanning your pet's medical records to a USB device in case of emergency)
Food and water, bowls, medications, supplements and vitamins (even a few extra in case of a delayed return home)
Disposal bags for pet waste and cleaning supplies for emergencies
Grooming supplies, including an old towel in case of rain or after swimming
Favorite blanket, bed and toys
Leash and collar with up-to-date ID tags (with your cell phone number), microchip information, rabies tags and/or fully-charged GPS device
If your dog suffers from motion sickness, give your dog medication with a small amount of food two hours before traveling.
