

Pet Travel Checklist

- Appropriate restraint device, travel crate, or carrier
- Proof of vaccinations (consider scanning your pet's medical records to a USB device in case of emergency)
- Food and water, bowls, medications, supplements and vitamins (even a few extra in case of a delayed return home)
- Disposal bags for pet waste and cleaning supplies for emergencies
- Grooming supplies, including an old towel in case of rain or after swimming
- Favorite blanket, bed and toys
- Leash and collar with up-to-date ID tags (with your cell phone number), microchip information, rabies tags and/or fully-charged GPS device
- If your dog suffers from motion sickness, give your dog medication with a small amount of food two hours before traveling.
